

(A) Field visit report of the Vigilance and Monitoring team on 16.07.2011

Karimpur-I Block : In pursuance of order no. 1287(14)/III/P & R D Krishnagar, Dt. 13.09.2011, S. Choudhury, D.W.O., B.C.W., Nadia, Sri Ajay Kumar Khan, Representative of Sri, Tapas Paul, Hon' ble M.P., 12, Krishnagar P.C. and Savapati Karimpur-II Panchayat Samity attended at Karimpur-I Block at 1.00 p.m. Due to excessive Rainfall, field visit was taken up later on. Inspected the performance at Block Office at first.

1. N.R.E.G.A. Programme : The Block consists of 8 (Eight) Gram Panchayats. It appears that the 3 (Three) Gram Panchayats are keeping Balance amount more than 10 Lkhs. Asked the B.D.O. and Savapati to utilise immediately as per approved plan. They may take up different schemes alongwith the individual beneficiary scheme (Preferably).

Funds are required in respect of 4 (Four) Gram Panchayats namely Karimpur-II, Jamserpur, Hare Krishnapur and Pipulberia. One scheme is running in respect of Madhubari G.P.

2. B.S.K.P. (Bangla Swanirvar Karmasansthan Prakaipa) : No. of cases sanctioned in 2010-11 are 53 out of 99 cases but no sanction has yet been made in 2011-12 although 58 schemes are sponsored. Canara Bank, Kechuadanga may be requested to release 3.48 lakhs in respect of Eight beneficiaries as subsidy amount for the year 2010-11. Immediate steps should be taken to disburse the same by the bank concerned.

3. P.M.G.S.Y. : Two roads are on execution as reported by B.D.O. (1) Gabradanga to Bajitpur road and (2) Hare Krishnapur road.

4. S.G.S.Y. : There are 1306 self Help groups Details are shown below.

7. Visited Jamserpur Gram Panchayat by the team, B.D.O. and Jt. B.D.O.: Pradhan, Gram Panchayat was present. All the staff were also present. Even few members of G.P. are there during visiting. Post of one panchayat karmee is still vacant.

Mid-Day-Meal of schools are running.

- b) Maintenance Charges to S.C. and S.T. students : No such pending is on 2010-11
- c) N.R.E.G.A. :- Arabpur Primary School : 600 wages out of 1600 had been deployed for land development works. Payment has been made timely. Moreover two schemes i.e. one earth filling work of a road and one tree plantation work by the side of khal are also visited. Proper procedure has been maintained to execute the schemes.
- d) Rural Sanitation Programme :- Only 900 out of 2500 family (Appr.) are covered in Total sanitation Programme. Progress is not upto the mark.
- e) Untied fund : Three schemes are done :
- Waiting Room at Bansberia Bus Stop
 - Boundary Wall of Muktodaha Pri. School
 - Arabpur Sardarpara Pri. School.

Remarks : Two days' inspection programme is required in this Block as the Block is situated more than 100 kms. from the District Head Quarter at Krishnagar. B.D.O. should give special attention in N.R.E.G.A. schemes by the Gram Panchyats. He will also look in to the increasing of construction of sanitations in Rural Sanitation programme.

Then I held a meeting with the Joint B.D.O. and all staff of NREGS Cell of Chakdah Block and discussed elaborately all aspects of the scheme. Then we choose two G.Ps for field visit jointly.

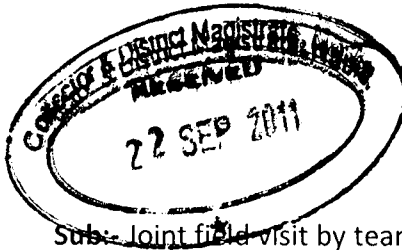
First I visited Khergachi G.P. with the Jt. B.D.O and other staff and examine a road from Khergachi Primary School to Dargatala and discussed with the nearby villagers for cross checking and found O.K.

In that G.P. I also visited the field development works near Raetari Masque under NREGS and found O.K.

Then I visited Simurali G.P. with the Jt. B.D.O. and other staff and examine (1) a repairing work of W.B.M road under NREGS from Chatpukur to Baresake amounting Rs.95,968=00 and fund o.k. (2) renovation fund of Samser Mondal amount of Rs.80,416=00 and found o.k.

There is only one direction to the Jt. B.D.O. for exhibit a permanent display of any work under NREGS. Other member of D.L.V.C. of my team was not present on that day.

Visit Report

Sub: Joint field visit by teams – comprising by members of DLV & MC, Nadia.

Date & time of visit- 16.07.2011 at 12.00 Noon.

Place of visit- Office of the Block Development Officer, Kaliganj, Debagram.

Particulars of visit- Smt Roshni Das, Block Development Officer, Kaliganj and Executive Officer of Kaliganj Panchayat Samity had casually taken this visit of District level vigilance and monitoring committee. The following points will reveal the truth;

- 1) She did not ask all block officials to present during this visit. A few officials, namely Jt. BDO, PDO, APO, SAE (RWP), Clerk-in-Charge & officials of NREGA Cell were present.
- 2) She, Block Development Officer, Kaliganj could not place complete documents/papers with respect to any particular schemes/projects/funds before the team. That means she did not give any importance to the visiting officials.
- 3) She introduced one Romani Mohan Bagchi to be the acting head clerk -cum- accountant (i.e. Clerk in-charge) who could not produce allotment register, scheme register, stock register etc. The DNO, NREGA duly remarked that the said clerk in-charge (Romani Babu) was not only an inefficient official but also a non-performing staff.
- 4) Cashiers of the block & the P.S have not been present. So physical verification of cash was not possible. It may be assumed that the cash books were not up-to-date and absence of cashiers indicated so.
- 5) The tender committee following the West Bengal Panchayat (Zilla Parishad & Panchayat Samity) Accounts and Finance Administration Rules, 2003 had been formed on 21.07.2009 by Artho-Sangstha-Unnayan O Porikalpana Sthayee Samity. But this BDO & EO did not give effect of such tender committee since her joining.
From the above mention points 3, 4 & 5 it is clear that the Executive Officer blatantly violated the said Finance Administration Rules, 2003.
- 6) The SAE (RWP), could not produce budget approval of a particular amount spent in a scheme, nor did submit papers in favour of wide publicity before tender opened. That means the Executive Officer has not been maintaining transparency during tender floated since her joining.
- 7) The two schemes were visited by this team. The output of these executed schemes was not satisfactory. The G.P Officials were told to replace some materials. The names of two schemes are 1) Land development at Gobindapur SSK under MGNREGS fund cost- Rs. 54, 360.00. 2) Construction of culvert near land of Balai Chand Biswas at Bharatpur under 13th FC fund cost- Rs. 2,59,580.00.
- 8) The physical verification of IGNOAPS beneficiaries have not been completed yet. Single pence of IAY fund has not been distributed to beneficiaries since October 2009 when Smt. Das took charge of this block.
- 9) The ELA Audit reply for Panchayat Samity in broadsheet has not been sent to District Authority. It is even not prepared yet. The inspection report of ELA is kept with the Clerk in-Charge who knows nothing.

Special remarks:-

It seems Smt. Roshni Das, Block Development Officer & Executive Officer, Kaliganj has no control over block staff. The Jt. BDO & the PDO, it is revealed on query, have not been given any specific responsibilities.

Smt. Das is supposed to have not developed any professional skill as BDO during her tenure.

The post of Head Clerk-cum-Accountant has been lying vacant since February 2010. Since then Sri Romani Mohan Bagchi has been acting as Clerk in-charge who is incompetent and sycophant who seems to be a personal attendant of BDO, Kaliganj.

This report is submitted to the District Magistrate, Nadia through the District Nodal Officer, MGNREGA who is requested to put down his own observations and the same is also forwarded to Hon'ble MLA, 81- Nakashipara for his kind perusal and taking necessary action.

INSPECTION REPORT

As decided in the District Level Vigilance and Monitoring Committee meeting held on 2/7/2011..... I along with two other member appeared the office of Block Development Officer, Kaliganj on 16.07.2011. ,

The observation about the Panchayat Samity as follows:-

- 1) In spite of prior intimation Block Development Officer failed to present some documents like Cash Book, Allotment Register and Scheme Register as most of the employees who are in charge of the above documents were absent.
- 2) As the Budget was not passed by Panchayat Samity due to stalemate condition in the Panchayat Samity, so most of the works remained suspended. So, the Panchayat Samity is completely defunct.
- 3) On scheme register maintained by one SAE, Sanjib Babu was consulted. In the scheme register the estimate for the work construction of Bathingghat near Jyosudayini Temple under Barochandghar Gram Panchayat was shown as Rs. 1.20 Lakh but during last year the Artha Sthayee Samity approved a fund amounting Rs. 0.80 Lakh.
- 4) The meeting of the tender committee are not being held regularly.
- 5) Recently tender for 34 schemes has been taken up. Last date of dropping tender 05.08.2011.
- 6) Complain Register is not well maintained.
- 7) From Block office we visited two schemes –
 - i) Filling of Earth in the Ground of Gogindapur SSK under taken by Mira –II GP through the work started 7 days ago. Approximate mandays generated 330, but the out put of work is very poor as quantum of earth found at the worksite 900 cft. That means the maximum mandays, might be near to 90 to 100.
 - ii) The name of the scheme visited culvert at Bharatpur, width of the culvert was 5 meter. The brick used in the scheme was not upto the mark. The contactor engaged for the scheme was directed to replace the bricks with bricks upto the mark.

As per Order vide Memo No. 1287(14)/III/P&RD Dated 13/07/2011 we went for field visit at Hanskhali Block & Gram Panchayat under this Block. During office visit as well as field visit the following facts were revealed:

4. Hanskhali Block

MGNREGS : In the year 2010-2011 total Fund received in this Block of Rs. 6.02 Crore

Cumulative expenditure upto June'2011 - Rs. 1.51 Crore

IGNOAPS : Fund disbursed upto December 2011 and subsequent disbursement was under process.

MSDP : Total Rs. 1.51 Crore was pending. Fund received for 61 no. of sites. But sites for 20 locations were not finalized.

BEUP : Construction of Jhama Bats Road from Ghosh Kamalpur PMGSY Rd. to Station Para near the H/O Bisnu Sardar had been started. Sanction amount of Rs. 1.70 Lakh

BADP : Road from Ramnagar Bazar to Kumari IBB Rd. (2nd Phase) had some problem where it was found that after completion of the work, some portion of the top layer of black top was damaged. BDO & SAE was requested to look into the matter & to get the damaged portion re-casted after monsoon.

2) Tapan Biswas, Son of Lt. Dharendra Nath Biswas, Ramnagar Mallick Para received Rs. 25,000/- in the year 2009-10 for the IAY Scheme. He constructed the Pucca Building with Tin Shed. But there was no logo on the house.

Villagers complaint that the following persons received fund from the G.P but did not constructed their houses :

a) Lakshmi Biswas , Son of Hagari, Ramnagar

b) Tulshi Bala Ghosh, Son of Santosh – Ramnagar,

Pradhan was instructed to look into the matter & report to the BDO.

Minutes of the meeting of DLVMC held on 22.09.2011 in the Meeting Hall of Nadia Zilla Parishad at 11:00 a.m.

In absence of the Chairman, DLVMC, Nadia, the Sabhadhipati, Nadia Zilla Parishad presided over the meeting as Chairperson. At the outset he briefed about the committee. He said that one of the objectives of committee was to liquidate any hurdles in implementation of schemes and bring about transparency at all level. He assured that it was not a body 'to find fault' only. He also informed that the list of schemes to be monitored by the committee had been given in the form of Booklet and circulated to all members. Then he added that small teams would be formed for field visit as was down in earlier occasions.

Following this reporting and briefing of different schemes as per agenda was taken up by the respective officials. And a threadbare discussion was made on each agenda by honourable members.

The following points came up after the discussion:

PMGSY:

- a) A scheme named Jalkar Mathurapur need be executed and completed at any cost.
- b) All PMGSY schemes which were locked up during election need be taken up and completed.
- c) Inequality in Sanctioning Schemes amongst the Panchayat Samitis in term of fund need be mitigated.

Action : AEO, Nadia Zilla Parishad.

IAY:

- a) Inequality in Sanctioning IAY fund amongst the Panchayat Samiti need be mitigated.
- b) A detail report in respect of ASHRAY need be circulated before the next meeting of DLVMC.
- c) Inspection is required to be done for the ASHRAY Scheme Sanctioned in Dharmada (Bahirgachhi).
- d) One Archana Mondal in Bhimpur Gram Panchayat received IAY house thrice – An inspection and report needed.
- e) District Level Officers distributed IAY fund without the knowledge of Sabhapati's & Prodhans - Sabhapati's as well as Prodhans should be intimated before hand.
- f) If there is any instance of diversion of IAY Fund, FIR should be lodged against that person.

Action : AEO, Nadia Zilla Parishad.

NSAP:

- a) Two cases of getting double pension were detected and action taken. All members are requested to be vigilant and make out specific case and forward for talking action.
- b) It is requested to see that person getting BPL Pension should not get the APL Pension as well.
- c) A camp for Disability Pension was going to be arranged soon (preferably after the Puja Vacation).

Action : DP&RDO, Nadia

SGSY:

- a) A letter from District indicating the construction of Cluster / Sub-Cluster and arrangement for evaluation there of need be issued to all concerned.
- b) This is not an Urban based programme.

Action : PD, DRDC, Nadia

NREGA:

- a) Schemes for 100 days not being done properly in Sadhanpara-I Gram Panchayat (Krishnagar-II Dev. Block. Ref. November, 2011). One road scheme reported to have executed twice.
- b) One xerox copy of a paper cutting was given to DNO, NREGA for taking necessary action.
- c) It was requested to make a proposal for decreasing the minimum quantity of earth cutting of 100 cft. for getting wage for a Manday.

Action : DNO, NREGA

SC/ST Welfare:

- a) Some tribe people belonging to Oraon Community use the Sardar Title – they do not get the benefit – to look after such cases.
- b) Adopting the Cancellation Process. Certificate given to wrong persons are excluded after proper verification.

Action : DNO, Nadia

District Magistrate, Nadia requested the honourable members to check properly before making any complaints and not to indulge in any hearsay. He also added that there should an information sharing cycle i.e. complaint made Action taken Feed back.

Sabhadhipati, Nadia Zilla Parishad pointed out that :

- a) All important guidelines relating to the communication ^{intae} would be made available by the next meeting.
- b) In constituting teams for Field Visit for distant Blocks necessary arrangements and special care would be taken.
- c) If there is any specific information with members, which may be sent to the Office of the DLVMC, Nadia so that the same may be placed in the next meeting.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks.
