

Minutes of the D.L.C.M.A. Meeting held on 14.09.11 at 2.00 P.M. in the conference Hall of the Nadia Collectorate Building (3rd Floor)

Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia took the chair and welcomed all of the D.L.C members for attending the meeting and the meeting started. Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia at first explained elaborately the importance of M.S.D.P. Scheme adopted by the Government for uplifting the minorities section. In M.S.D.P. Programme there are so many schemes like I.A.Y., A.W.C., A.C.R., P.H.C., Sinking of Arsenic free Tube-wells, M.E.L. and S.S.K. Protection of Graveyards etc.

Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia initiated the discussion before the house on the presentation in connection with the status report on MSDF.

DOMA informed the house that 10,617 Nos. of Pre-Matric & 1,735 nos. of Post Matric scholarship application forms have been received by this Office.

Mr. Nasiruddin Ahamed, MLA & Chairperson of the Standing Committee of State Level Minority Affairs wanted to know about the vacancies (Retired Staff) lying in the DOMA, Nadia Office

Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia informed that out of eleven (11) posts, 3(three) post have been field up and the rest will be filled up shortly.

Regarding AWC, Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia told that cost effective technology may be taken to complete the work smoothly. She also informed the house that some (Site change) of AWC may be done depending on the average percentage of minority people of the Blocks

Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia also proposed that AWC may be constructed in the Primary School premises and order in this regard has already been communicated to all EDOs.

Representative of MLA (Krishnagar North), Shri Shibu Chowdhury suggested that a list of beneficiaries for IAY and AWC to be given to the MLAs. In this regard Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia informed that GPS mapping of AWC & IAY has been sought for from the EDOs. If available, the same will be communicated to the members in the next meeting.

Regarding 16 (sixteen) Arsenic Free Tube Wells, Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia also suggested that Arsenic Free Tube Well may be distributed among the willing Blocks.

Mr. Nasiruddin Ahmmed, MLA & Chairperson of the Standing Committee of State Level Minority Affairs, informed in the house that Govt. of West Bengal pay much emphasize for the welfare of the minority section. He also demanded to call the DLC meeting on Monday because the MLAs are less burdened on Monday. He also raised question in the house not to give the cheque of IAY direct to the beneficiary because there are so many instance of misuse of money. So he suggested to construct the IAY through Agency under direct super vision of the District.

He also proposed for construction of ITI (Industrial Training Institute) in Kaliganj & Chapra block as the Percentage (%) of minority people in the two blocks are high.

Another point he raised about the status of Paninala English Medium Madrasah. In reply Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia tolled that early action will be taken with the consultation of PWD.

He also wanted to know about the status report of OBC certificate. In reply he was told that issuing of OBC certificate is not done by DOMA but these are issued from SDO level.

Another question he raised about the safety tank of Saydul Haque Muslim Girl's Hostel at Hoshnagar. The present safety tank is not sufficient to provide the needs for more than hundred boarders. Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia suggested that DOMA will contact with District Engineer and chalk out the solution and inform the matter to CEO, Water Board.

The Chairmen, Nabadwip Municipality wanted to know the procedure of application for permitting the Grave yard under his Municipality jurisdiction. He was told to submit application enclosing the plan & estimate and land porcha.

Lastly Mr. Nasiruddin Ahmmed, MLA & Chairperson of the Standing Committee of State Level Minority Affairs made a proposal that the fund of ACR received recently to be utilized in such a manner that MBMs & Madrasah's are benefited more.

Additional District Magistrate (Gen.), Nadia asked the members present to raise if there be any question to discuss.

As there is no other points to discuss the meeting was ended with thanks to and from the chair.
