### **Some Facts about UPSC:**

**Age Limit:** A candidate must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 32 years.

**Minimum Educational Qualification:** A candidate must hold a Graduate degree of any of the Universities incorporated by an Act of the central or State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 or possess an equivalent qualification.
