**MGNREGA:** The main objective of MGNREGA Scheme is to provide employment to the unemployed labours. With a view to achieving the goal, this District so far provided employment to 3.45 lakhs labourers out of which 0.91 lakh of women had been provided employment. This District has given stress not only to employment but also to create durable assets such as Roads, Culverts and to create sustainable economic development.

One of the most remarkable endeavours is to supply the saplings of the plants which may yield fruits with economic value to the individuals who also may have the scope for employment in the orchard/field of their own. This District in the last years undertook such schemes for production of 3, 93,480 nos of Drumstick plants which bear crops twice in a year and 8,05,875 nos. of Papaya tree. This year this District taken up schemes for supplying 1,59,508 nos. of Tissue Cultured Banana Plant through SGSY and SHG Groups and under this scheme plantation in 5 cottah of land may generate income of Rs. 15,000/- per year in just 11 months. District targeted to plant 1,96,350 nos. of special type of Bamboo variety ( Bambusa Balcoa) by which we will be able to mitigate the pollution of air as this plants absorbs maximum Carbon monoxide and Carbon dioxide gases. The Bamboo will begin their production within 4 (four) years and growth continue for years. Thus we will be able to achieve the twin objectives of income generation with eco-friendly sustainable development.

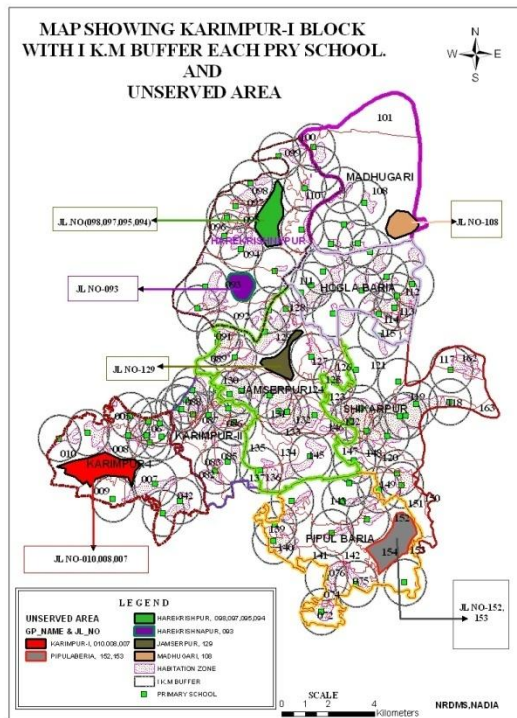
This District successfully converged the various schemes which generally are implemented by other Departments like – Forest, Fishery, Sericulture, Agriculture and Horticulture Deptt. with MGNREGA.

The inspection structure has been formed comprising of starting from District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrates, Dy. Magistrates, Block Development Officers & down to the level of Extension Officers to look after the Development Schemes running in Block and Gram Panchayat for improvement of quality and timely intervention wherever required.

### Introduction of GIS system In SSM Nadia

All Educational Institutions including ICDS Centres had been plotted on the GIS Map of the District along with Geographical Coordinates. Also photographs had been taken in respect of all educational Institutions including SSKs, MSKs, ICDS Centres and Private Institutions and data attachment had already been made as per DISE report.

The SSM, Nadia is planning to develop GIS based Database Management System for the District of Nadia. Already unserved areas have been identified through GIS maps and locations are being identified for setting up of New Set up Primary and Upper Primary Schools

**Including the Excluded :  
Empowering Tribal people  
by registering them in the  
Electoral Roll**

In a unique effort to include the tribal people traditionally left out of the Electoral Roll in 92 Kalyani AC of Nadia district, the Sub-Divisional team of under the leadership of SDO, Kalyani included 288 no of tribal people in the Electoral Roll of 126, Sidhu Kanhu Nagar Pry School. The exercise matched with physical verification by SDO and ERO, 92 AC is being hailed as path-breaking by experts and media alike.

### Research Work to Improve Teaching and Learning in classroom environments

It is often experienced that capacity of teaching and learning at Primary and Upper Primary levels is not uniform and the performance of pupils also leaves a lot to be improved upon.

A research study is being conducted in association with Kalyani University to study the impact of present methods of learning on students. The sample fairly exhaustive is spread across the district.

All the stake holders are being involved to contribute to the programme. The study is scheduled to be completed by November, 2011.



### **Supervision and Monitoring: Outcome Analysis of Development Schemes.**

In an effort to bolster intensive monitoring of development schemes, District Administration entrusts an Extension Officer in charge of one Gram Panchayat as Guardian Officer of GP. Over and above the Extension Officers, an extensive structure of monitoring is put in place commencing with the Block Development Officer and reaching up to the District Magistrate and Collector, Nadia. It is envisaged that schemes shall be selected *suo-motu* by the enquiring Officers for detailed visit and inspection. It shall be adequately documented and monitored on a regular basis.

### **Toning up Administration: Skill Development initiatives by District Administration.**

District administration has taken special drives for capacity building amongst staff of all offices of District Nadia. The District started a pilot programme "*Training for all*" in collaboration with ATI West Bengal, Salt Lake using Regional Training Centre, in the Collectorate Building (3<sup>rd</sup> Floor). Earlier, e-payment of salary scheme in respect of all State Govt. Officers has been introduced through preparation of Salary Bill by COSA software package with the help of NIC, Nadia. Simultaneously, training to on e-office system has been given to all Supervisors of the Collectorate. A number of related efforts on human resource management are in the offing. Very lately in the month of August, a two days' Orientation Programme had been held on executive Magistracy at the Administrative Conference Room of the Office of the District Magistrate, Nadia.

### **Nadia District launches its e-governance Plan**

Nadia District launches its e-governance plan to provide speedier disposal of service to the citizens. Already all programmes of the district and related information have been laid open in the public domain. Now, efforts are being taken to operationalise programmes oriented to e-governance system. After a comprehensive training to all Supervisors, basic infrastructure creations along with procurement of necessary equipments are being made.

### **Returning to Roots: Introducing Yoga Classes**

The district administration introduced Yoga classes of 15 days' duration, "*Art of Living*" among the inmates of Krishnagar District Correctional Home. In the Krishnagar District Correctional Home, the District Administration in collaboration with NABARD and District Industrial Centre, Nadia, Skill Development Initiative Programme for women inmates in Tailoring trade has been launched from 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2011.

### **Border Area Development Programme : District Initiatives**

BADP is a fully Central Government Sponsored Scheme with an aim to develop Infrastructure at the International Boarder Area for better Socio-economic standard of the people of those areas. The District Administration also given emphasis on quality implementation and monitoring. For this purpose, a team has been constituted under the Chairmanship of DM, Nadia and with members including ADM (Dev), District Engineer & Dist. Planning Officer. This team has started inspecting & monitoring of BADP schemes. We are also using GIS system of mapping for those BADP schemes which will enable the administration to locate the scheme instantly and to identify whether such scheme has already been taken up from any other sources.

In the photograph here, Construction of Na-Ghata Bridge under B.A.D.P at Krishnaganj Dev. Block is shown.

Total cost of the scheme was 25.00 lakhs, Executing Agency was P.W.D, Nadia Highway Division-I. It facilitated better road connectivity fulfilling long pending demand of the people of the area as Majdia Bhajanghat Road is join with Bagula-Nonaganj Road through the construction of Bhajanghat Bridge.



Due to this, Majdia is directly connected with Bagula through roadway. Simultaneously widening and strengthening of Bagula – Nonaganj Road with 5.5 M. width black top enhance the importance of the Majdia – Bhajanghat Road to a large extent.
