MOBILE LIBRARY FOR THE JAILED

KRISHNAGAR (NADIA): To provide books to jail inmates, Nadia district library officials launched a mobile library on Wednesday.

Library Day was observed on August 31 by the Nadia district library authorities across the district. Nadia district magistrate Sumit Gupta inaugurated the mobile library service on a motorised vehicle in Krishnagar on Wednesday. After inauguration, the mobile library went to a government home in Krishnagar's Nagendranagar area and later went to Krishnagar jail.

Mrityunjay Mitra, district library officer, said this is a first-of-its-kind initiative in the state. "On Wednesday, we started the service in Krishnagar, Kalyani and Tehatta. All these places have jails nearby. There is one more jail in Ranaghat. The service will be started there too very soon. We have a plan to start the service in all government homes in Nadia," said Mitra. HYC
